Rubber Cleaning & Maintenance

Rubber extrusions are coated with a white chalky residue known as soapstone, which is used as an anti-sticking agent in the curing and transportation of the products. Due to the industrial applications of this material, many users elect to simply leave the material as is. If a more finished appearance is desired, the following instructions may be used for both extruded and molded products.

Cleaning

- Rubber may be cleaned with an all-purpose spray cleaner such as Simple Green® and Formula 409®.
- Products such as Armorall® and similar cleaning products provide excellent cleaning and enhanced "sheen" providing rubber with a clean, uniform appearance.

Maintenance

- After initial cleaning of rubber to remove soapstone, no additional routine maintenance is required. Rubber may be cleaned on a "as needed" basis as project and conditions warrant.
